## Rules

Entry Fee of \$5 per Scarecrow & Registration Form must be received before anyone may pick up a Scarecrow Frame.

Unregistered scarecrows will not be accepted, or displayed as part of the event.

Materials that deteriorate, rot or may begin to smell in the long term use of its display. (ie, vegetables, gourds)

Please refrain from subject matter that is overly rude, violent, obscene, or otherwise offensive. It is probably best to avoid Political and Religious themes.

Size restrictions are as follows: Scarecrows cannot be over 7 feet tall, 8 feet wide and 3 feet deep.

No dangerous, hazardous, or illegal materials will be accepted.

All materials must be safely secured to frame of your creation. The same goes for any “accessories” independent of the frame. Although most will be displayed indoors before the auction, after that they are intended to be outdoor decorations.

The Historic Courthouse District members and those directly organizing the event have the right to refuse any entry and if Scarecrow is returned and deemed unacceptable, no refunds will be made.

## Tips

Have Fun! Old Halloween costumes and/or uniforms make quick, easy, and inexpensive Scarecrow clothing.

Scarecrows don't have to be “stuffed.” If you want more form to your Scarecrow, crumpled up newspaper in a plastic bag, old towels, sheets, Styrofoam wrapped in plastic, trash bags or additional lumber can achieve the desired effect.

Represent your club or organization. (Girl Scouts=uniform + empty cookie box, Book Club=book in “hand”)

Represent your favorite sporting team. (From Football Helmet or Baseball Bat to Pom Poms or Hockey Gloves)

Make a scene! Why stop at just one? OSU vs. Michigan. Family of 4 (Mom, Dad, kids)

When securing all items to frame, nails, staples, duct tape and screws work the best. (Screws don't work well when going through fabric, the fabric becomes twisted)
